Line of Inquiry:

Next week we start exploring our second line of inquiry, "Heroes devote their lives to promoting the rights of others." We be studying specific individuals from American history (MLK, Cesar Chavez and Dolores Huertas, Harriet Tubman, Clara Barton, Norman Borlaug, etc), but encourage students to seek examples of heroes from around the globe (Malala Yusefzai, Mother Teresa, Christian X of Denmark, etc). They can bring in books, articles, pictures, or even just a name.

Drop-Off/Pick Up:

The drop off/pick up zone for 2-12th grade has been moved to the blacktop area just west of the MPR. There are cones and duty-teachers to monitor the area.

We think this system will be much quicker with loading/unloading than our old spot near the frontage road, so please bear with us while we work out any kinks these first weeks.
