# **Back to School Changes**

The school calendar has changed.

- Our first full day was August 5<sup>th</sup>, 2019. The last day of school will be May 22, 2020.
- Our daily schedule has also changed slightly, to hopefully promote better attendance. On Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday school will start promptly at 8:00 AM and end at 2:30 PM. On Wednesdays CIS will start at 8:00 AM and end at 1:30 PM. The gates will still open at 7:30 AM and Kindergarten and 1st grade will be released about 10 minutes early.
- For after school, we will be working with Permaculture to offer good, affordable care. As part of the Extended Learning Time Program CIS will also be offering an academic component to after school time. CIS is working with Permaculture to offset the cost, to some of our families, which the increase of three extra hours a week has caused.

The early start date, the schedule, and the added days during the school year provides CIS added funding through the Extended School Year grant offered by the Public Education Department. This funding helps us offset the loss of the Small School Size Adjustment funds that was eliminated by the New Mexico Legislature.

# **Drop off and Pick up**

- \*Enter from Wilshire, exit onto the South bound frontage road.
- \*There are two lines entering the pick-up area in the afternoon. Once you pass the 2<sup>nd</sup> gate stay to the right or left. The middle area is for exiting once your children are in your car.
- \*Do not exit your car while in the pick up or drop off line at any time. If you have business in the school please park on the street and come to the front office.
- \*Do not go faster than 5 mph while on school grounds.
- \*Do not use any of the surrounding businesses as a pick up or drop off.
- \*Do not use your cell phone while driving.

## **Attendance**

Please try to schedule appointments after school. With the earlier release time it should make it easier to do this. Also, please do not pick up your child early from school unless it is absolutely necessary. It is not an acceptable way to beat the pick-up line. From the time the students  $3^{rd}$  to  $10^{th}$  grade are released at 3:30 it takes 10 - 12 minutes for us to clear the pick-up area.

Student attendance is one of the MOST common predictors of academic achievement. This is proven research. If you don't work, you don't get paid. If students are not in school, we can't teach them. Simple analogy.
