

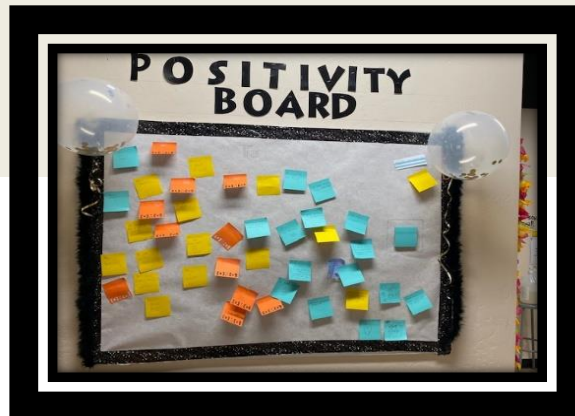

Dear parents,

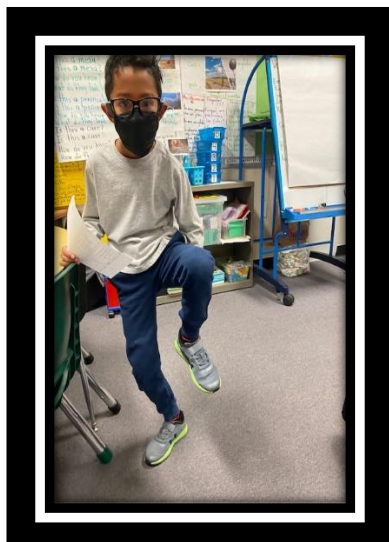
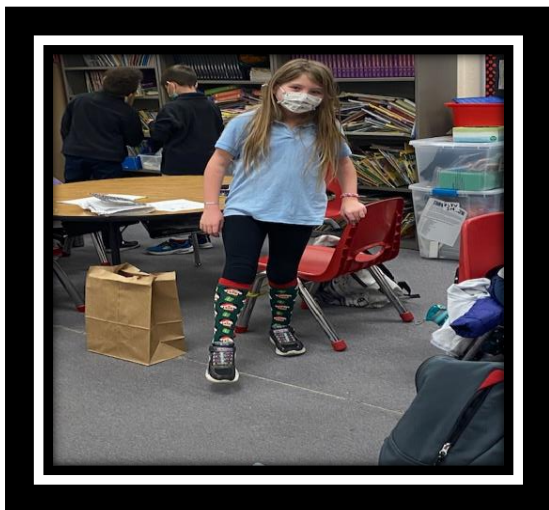
